I wish to apply for the scholarship that will provide me with up to \$500.00, which I will match with an equal amount, to be applied towards an aviation related activity that will further my goals in an aviation career.

I understand the following conditions:

EAA Chapter 1111 will make the final determination on my eligibility to apply for the scholarship and the eligibility of the aviation related activity.

I am required to submit copies of expenses, in order to qualify for reimbursement, and I am responsible to submit copies of the expenses within 30 days of the incurred expense. Upon approval, EAA Chapter 1111 will reimburse at 50% up to the full amount of the \$500 award.

I am required to provide EAA Chapter 1111 with a written progress report when 50% of the funds have been expended by EAA Chapter 1111. I understand that failure to adequately show program success could result in scholarship termination.

I am required to provide EAA Chapter 1111 with a written final report, attached to the last reimbursement request, stating how the aviation related activity has benefited my aviation career.

I am ineligible for any scholarship through EAA Chapter 1111 if any relatives serve on the current board, are on the scholarship selection committee, or my current annual GPA is less than 3.0 (applicant may need to provide proof of GPA upon request).
